World Hindi Day: Introduction

- This day is celebrated every year with the aim of promoting the use of Hindi language abroad.
- On 10 January 2006, the World Hindi Conference was organised for the first time in Nagpur to promote Hindi language worldwide.
- Since then this day is celebrated as World Hindi Day.

World Hindi Day



- Last year, on the occasion of World Hindi Day, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization-UNESCO had agreed to publish the Hindi description of India's World Heritage Sites on its website.
- Significantly, Hindi is the fourth most spoken language in the world.



Hindi Diwas: At a Glance

Hindi Day 14 September

Hindi was declared the official language under Article 343 (1).

26 January 1965

Became the official language of the country.
